RubiconMD was recently informed that effective October 1, 2022 eConsults are no longer eligible for Category 1 CME credits. The AAFP recently shifted its stance on eConsults which resulted in this change.

We recognize that you may use the RubiconMD platform to help fulfill a portion of your CME credit requirements and apologize for any inconvenience that this may cause.
